

Parking Information

On Campus (please refer to the campus parking map):

For those participants **staying in Sewall Residence Hall**, parking lot 136 has been assigned. Permits can be purchased at the Residence Hall front desk for \$22 for a week. Permits are required 7 days a week. The commuter lots described below would also be available at Parking and Transportation Services. Daily rates are available, Saturdays and Sundays are free, but they are further away from the residence hall.

For **commuters**, all driving directions take you to the Parking and Transportation Services Building (<http://www.colorado.edu/parking/parking/permits/temporary.html>). Temporary parking permits can be purchased there, \$7.75 per day, or \$22 for a week. The lots that they will assign include 436/494 a couple of blocks southeast of Carlson, 169 northeast of Carlson (dirt lot, steep hill) or the Grandview Area northwest of Carlson. All of these lots are free on Saturday and Sunday, so it does not make much sense to purchase a weekly permit.

Hourly pay lots are available. Euclid Autopark – from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. M-F, the EAP parking rate is \$1.75 per hour up to three hours. After three hours, the rate is \$3.00 per hour. The parking fee is \$3 from 5:00 p.m. until 11:30 p.m. each weeknight and all day Saturday and Sunday. EAP accepts payment by check and cash.

Pay Station lots (359) and meters rate is \$1.50 per hour. All pay stations accept credit cards (Visa, MasterCard, and American Express), meter debit cards, and coins. Some pay stations also accept bills.

Other possibilities:

Street parking in the neighborhood west of campus (South of Euclid, 13th, 14th, 15th, Streets, etc) is free, but available on a first come-first served basis, and would require a short 10-15 minute walk to Carlson.

The 29th Street retail district has free ground and covered parking. The "Hop" bus (clockwise) travels from there to the CU campus (\$2.00, c. 15 minutes) (http://www.bouldercolorado.gov/index.php?option=com_content&view=article&id=8825&Itemid=2994)

and would work for Friday and Saturday of the Seminar. Weekend schedules for the Hop begin too late to be useful for morning sessions.
